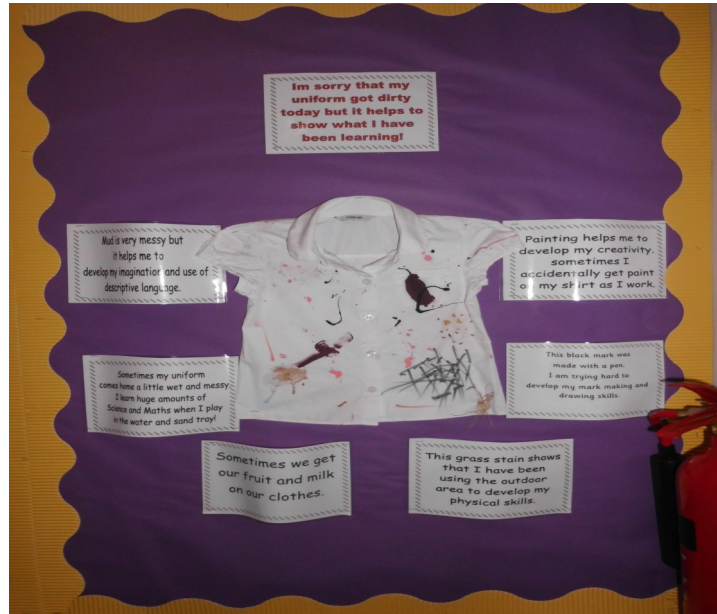


NURSERY Newsletter
