Reception

This week we have been learning about bears. We have been reading the story Goldilocks and the Three Bears. We have been sorting different sized objects into big, medium and small to match the three bears in the story. We have also been looking at pictures of different activities and deciding whether we do those activities during the day or night. We have been counting bears by joining two groups of bears together to find the total. We have also been learning about time this week. We have been looking at O'clock, finding the minute hand and hour hand and we have been looking at different times of the day. We have been practising our cutting skills by cutting out shapes to make teddy bears. We have been practising ball skills in PE this week.

Year One

This week in maths we have been dividing by four using number sentences, and we have been finding a quarter of shapes, pictures and numbers. In History this week we have been learning facts about Samuel Pepys and how he wrote his diary. In Art this week we have been using our designs and our knowledge of the Great Fire of London to make houses using junk modelling. In English this week we have been looking at Samuel Pepys. We pretended that we were living in 1666 and wrote our own diaries about the events of the Great Fire of London. In Science this week we evaluated the bucket experiment we conducted last week. We discussed what went well, and what we would change if we did our experiment again. In PE this week we have been playing football.

Year Two

This week we have been thinking about personal hygiene and all the ways we keep ourselves clean such as brushing our teeth and washing our hands. We conducted an experiment where we covered our hands in glitter and looked at which method was the best to remove the glitter. In Maths this week we have been revising addition and subtraction. We have been learning about Roald Dahl this week, and we have been reading the Enormous Crocodile. We wrote our own blurbs for the Enormous Crocodile. We have continued working on our handwriting, focussing on ascenders and descenders. In Art we have been creating some wonderful watercolour sketches of Ireland.
