Reception

This week we have been learning about Trolls from story books. We have written recipes for Troll soup with exciting ingredients. We have been making CVC words in Troll slime. We have been building bridges using foam bricks for the Billy Goats Gruff to escape the Trolls! We shared the story The Three Billy Goats Gruff with props and acting. We learnt lots about 3D shape this week and we practised and performed our assembly to our grown-ups!

Year One

This week in Maths we recapped subtraction and began solving missing box problems to ten and twenty. In English this week we have been doing levelled writing about the United Kingdom. In Geography this week we have been learning about Northern Ireland and some of the landmarks there. We have learnt about the Giant's Causeway and the Carrick-a-Rede rope bridge. In Art this week we have been learning about the Irish artist Yavan and we have been creating our own mosaic pictures.

Year Two

This week we have been focussing on writing. We have been reading Jack and the Beanstalk. We have been thinking about different sentence types such as exclamations, statements, questions and commands and we have been putting them in our stories. In Maths this week we have continued to look at fractions of shape such as quarters, halves and thirds. In PE this week we have continued to work on our ball skills. In History this week we have been learning about Robert Falcon Scott and his exploration. In Art this week we made some wonderful Jack and the Beanstalk themed models.
