Reception

This week we have been learning about space. We created our own aliens by picking a feature and rolling a dice to work out how many of our chosen features our alien would have. We have been using our fine motor skills to pick up stars using tweezers and put them in different pots. We made rockets using 3D shapes. We counted out aliens according to the numbers shown on flying saucers. We used oil pastels to sketch pictures of the planets. We made small books about the different planets using information we found from non fiction books. We played odd and Bob sorting games with real and alien words. We have been practising our zig zag monster hand-writing and in PE this week we have been practising our ball skills.

Year One

We started our week by baking bread as a 'wow' starter to our new Topic, London's burning. We had lots of fun baking and tasting our bread! We learnt the song London's burning and we have been looking at the story of London's burning. We looked at the beginning of the story, and how the fire started, and we have been making our own fire safety posters. We looked at the middle of the story, and predicted the ending. We have also written our own endings to the story. We have discussed how the fire could have been prevented, and in History this week we have looked at how the fire service has changed since 1666 to the present day. In Art this week we sketched houses from 1666. In Maths this week we have been looking at division and sharing equally between two.

Year Two

In Maths this week we have been finding fractions of an amount. We have been learning about Oliver Jeffers, a Northern Irish illustrator, artist and writer. We have been reading the story Lost and Found. We retold the story using puppets. We have been learning about different food groups and healthy diets. In Art this week we sketched Northern Irish scenes. We have been thinking about what Easter means to us, and in PE we have been playing team games.
