Multicultural Arts Week

Tiny Turtles

This week we have been learning about Texas. We learnt about different foods, we learnt about animals that live in Texas such as horses and armadillos, and we painted some lovely pictures of cacti at sunset. We made our own cowboy hats, and we learnt a song about a cowboy and cowgirl.

Sparkling Seahorses

This week we have been learning about Egypt. We did some food tasting, and we tried falafel and rice pudding. We have written our names in hieroglyphics, and we made our own Egyptian collars to wear in our assembly. We learnt a dance to the song Walk like an Egyptian, and we learnt an acrostic poem about Egypt.

Clever Clownfish

This week we have been learning about Laos. We looked at where Laos was on a map compared to the United Kingdom, and we learnt about different landmarks in Laos such as Pha That Luang. We did food tasting and tried noodles, mango and sticky rice. We learnt to count to 5 in Lao and we wrote our names in Lao.

This week we have been learning about Poland. We learnt about the Wieliczka Salt Mine, and we created some lovely watercolour paintings of the Salt Mine. We learnt about the Giewont mountain and the Vistula river. We learnt how to count from 1-5 in Polish, and we also learnt how to say hello and goodbye in Polish. We created a fact file on everything we have learnt about Poland.

This week we have been learning about Morocco. We did food tasting, and we tried cous cous, olives and pita bread. We read a book which compared life in Morocco to life in the United Kingdom. We had lots of fun learning a Moroccan dance and we made tiles and lanterns in Art. We also learnt how to write our names in Arabic.

This week we have been learning about Cuba. We have had lots of fun learning the Cha-cha-cha! We learnt some Spanish words and we tasted some different foods including mango, pineapple and coconut water. We've been looking at colourful buildings in Cuba and creating street scenes in Art.
