### This Week Reception

This week we have been learning about mermaids and unicorns. We have also been learning about money, and we have been looking at different coins and paying for ice-creams at the ice-cream shop. We conducted an experiment with skittles this week, where we poured hot water on the skittles to see what would happen. We watched as the colour came off the skittles and created a rainbow! We have drawn pictures of mermaids and unicorns in Art this week and we labelled our pictures.

We have been practicing our one armed robot handwriting in mermaid tails this week, and in PE we have continued using the apparatus.

### Year One

In Maths this week we have been recapping addition. We have been using all the methods we have learnt so far to solve addition problems. We have started learning how to subtract on a number line. We practised, and performed our assembly to our grown ups! We have been learning about Wales this week, and we looked at the different landmarks such as Cardiff Castle and Mount Snowdon. In English this week we made holiday brochures for Wales. In Art this week we sculpted our own versions of Cardiff Castle. In Science this week we have been looking at the weather in different parts of the UK and we made a weather report.

### Year Two

This week in Maths we have been learning fractions of different shapes, looking at halves and quarters. We have been reading the story Jack and the Beanstalk, and we have been looking at commands, questions, statements and exclamations. In Science this week we have been looking at microhabitats and minibeasts. We have been looking at the different microhabitats within the school grounds and what minibeasts live there. We have also been looking at local habitats, where we live, what keeps us safe and what open spaces we have to explore.
