

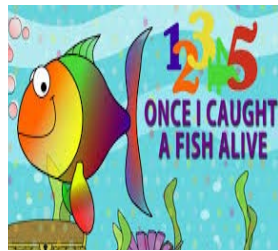
NURSERY Newsletter
